



Shire Ranger

This is a full-time permanent position in the Health and Regulatory Services section reporting to the Senior Ranger. You will provide Local Government Law Enforcement and assist with animal management including the operation of the Council's animal shelter.

- A Certificate IV in Local Government (Regulatory Services) or equivalent, or willingness and ability to acquire
- Demonstrated experience in Local Government Law enforcement or similar role
- Demonstrated experience in Livestock and companion animal handling, and
- A WA C Class driver's license.
