Learning on Country (LoC)
Shire Job for Senior Culture Person

The Job: Aboriginal local person who can run culture program for youth.
Where: 1 Job in each Yardgee, Mulan, Billiluna and Ringer Soak.
What: Help Youth understand culture and language with regular trips to country.

Specific Role:

- Do culture program your way – but must be our way too for Shire of Halls Creek funding.
- Work with local rangers, senior men/women, get permission to pass on culture, language and visit country.
- Make it happen - run program every time; get vehicles, staff, fuel - everything.
- Run meeting for LoC in your community – let the community know what's happening and let them help you too.
- Speak for Shire and LoC at other meetings and training.
- Keep safe LoC resources and materials and help teachers talk about culture and language with school kids.
- Put in pay sheets and reports on what you have been doing every time, so Shire can report back on your good work.

Location: Yardgee, Mulan, Billiluna and Ringer Soak

Hours: Couple Hours each day maybe – more on country trips, about 15 hours each week

4. Bring senior people to talk with us who can say “he/she is right person to teach our kids culture”.
