This is a full-time permanent position reporting to the Director Health and Regulatory Services. You will be responsible for coordinating the delivery of the regulatory function and educational programs and working with the community members to build a shared commitment to legislative provisions to protect and enhance the health of both, residents and their pets.

To be considered for this role, you must have Municipal Law A and B or equivalent, A WA (C) Class driver's licence, dog health qualifications and experience, be aware of Aboriginal culture and be able to work semi-autonomously.
