KEEPING YOUR HOME AND FAMILY SAFE

All properties must be prepared for the fire season

FIRE READY

Grass cut short

No easily flammable material

Easy to access



NOT FIRE READY

Dead trees, plants and long grass

Car bodies and rubbish

Difficult to access



Properties larger than 2000m² must also have adequate fire breaks

Emergency services must be able to easily access the firebreak. Firebreaks must be:

- Bare earth
- At least 3m wide
- Free from overhanging vegetation
- Safe for emergency vehicles to drive on
