INTENTION TO DISPOSE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROPERTY

Under section 3.58 of the Local Government Act 1995, the Shire of Halls Creek hereby advises of the intention to dispose of a piece of land, being Lot 101 DP68607, Volume 2761 Folio 441, located on Roberta Avenue, to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES) for the construction of an upgraded new Volunteer Fire and Emergency Services (VFES) Facility. The disposal is in exchange for developments at 8 Darcy Street, Lot 162 on DP170098 consisting of the Fire and Emergency Services Shed.

The piece of land is surplus to the Shire's needs, its value has not been determined. The new VFES facility will be of great benefit to the community in that;

- It provides a long lasting critical infrastructure for the Shire,
- It will be centrally located enhancing Volunteer Fire and Rescue response times,
- It is an upgrade to "Fit for Purpose" emergency services infrastructure,
- Its proximity to Halls Creek Police offers increased security outcomes for both the police and VFES, and
- Synergies for upgrade to existing Halls Creek VFES facilities include Emergency Operations and Training Rooms.

The Shire is now inviting submissions on the proposed disposal.
